If you are certain the sentence is correct or incorrect, write a large amount. If you are not very certain, write a smaller amount. You must put some money on every sentence. Remember, you only have \$1,000!
- Your teacher will then say which sentences are correct and which are incorrect.
- Calculate your score as follows: if you identified a sentence as correct or incorrect, and it was, you double the money you put on it. If you identified a sentence as correct or incorrect, but it wasn't, you lose the money you put on it.
- The winner is the pair or group who made the most money.
