6 I don't think \_\_\_\_\_ has ever eaten Chinese food.

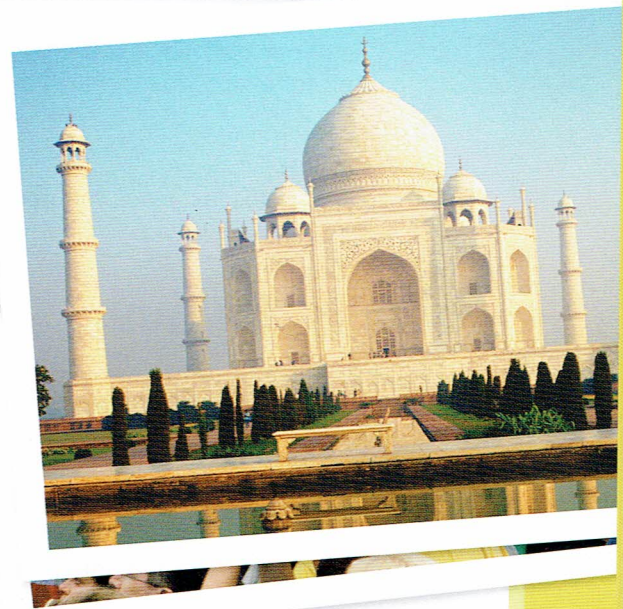
7 I think \_\_\_\_\_ has felt proud about something this week.
