



Communicative Wrap-up

1 Dilemma



Work in small groups. Follow the instructions and play the game.

- You need one counter for each player and a die. Place your counters on the "START" square. Each person in the group rolls the die. The person with the highest number goes first.
- Roll the die. Move the number of spaces indicated.
- When you land on a "Dilemma" square, read the dilemma aloud to the group. Choose your response to the dilemma, but don't tell anyone. Write your answer down in secret. The other players have to individually predict what answer you are going to choose and write it down. When everyone has done this, tell the group what you would do. Each player who guessed correctly scores one point. For each player who guessed incorrectly, you score one point. If you land on a "Dilemma" square on your next turn, roll again.
- The winner is the first player to score 10 points.

Dilemma

Lose one point.

If you found the answers to an important test, would you:
a) give them to your teacher without looking at them?
b) sell them to your classmates?
c) learn them and do really well on the test?

Skip your next turn.

If your friend had a really bad haircut, would you:
a) lie and say you liked it?
b) say what you thought of it—it's best to tell the truth?
c) suggest ways to make it look better?

Take another turn.

If you won the lottery, would you:
a) give some money to all your friends and family?
b) keep all the money for yourself?
c) make a large donation to a charity?

Go back four spaces.

Score one point.

If a friend started gossiping about another friend, would you:
a) warn him/her that you will tell your friends?
b) listen and then tell all your other friends?
c) listen but keep it secret?

Go forward three spaces.
